STATUTE ON PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

The University will set a schedule public holidays to be observed. This schedule will be set permanently from year to year unless amended.

These holidays include:

New Year's Day (January 1)
NRM Day (January 26)
International Women's Day (March 8)
Labour Day (May 1)
Martyrs' Day (June 3)
Independence Day (October 9)
Christmas Eve (December 24)
Christmas Day (December 25)
Boxing Day (December 26)

Good Friday Easter Monday Idd-el-Fitr (November) Idd-el-Aduha (January?)

When national elections are held, the University will observe only one day for the Presidential/Parliamentary elections. Staff who vote in other elections will do so on their own time.

In the case of special declared public holidays, the Vice Chancellor may choose to declare a university holiday.

In all other cases, University staff and students will be expected to be at work or class as normal.
